SITUATION

Shipston-on-Stour is a vibrant former market town situated in South Warwickshire and surrounded by undulating farmland. It has a predominantly Georgian High Street and Market Place which benefits from being away from through traffic. The town is a thriving local centre with a doctors' surgery and small NHS community hospital, excellent local shops including a butcher and a fishmonger, as well as a number of pubs and restaurants and recreational facilities, serving its own population and a number of surrounding villages.

Shipston-on- Stour was recently included in a survey in the Sunday Times as one of the top 10 market towns in which to live.

Further shopping and leisure activities are available in the surrounding market towns of Moreton-in-Marsh, Chipping Norton, Stratford-upon-Avon and Banbury.

Primary and secondary schools in Shipston-on-Stour and Chipping Campden (8 miles), grammar schools for boys and girls in Stratfordupon-Avon, independent schools include Tudor Hall, Bloxham, Kitebrook, Kingham Hill and The Croft whilst further afield are Cheltenham, Rugby, Warwick and Beaudesert Park.

Connections are good with a direct train service from Moreton-in-Marsh to London Paddington (from 87 minutes) and Banbury to London Marylebone (from 58 minutes). M40 (J11) at Banbury (about 15 miles) for London and the South or M40 (J12) Gaydon (about 16 miles) for Birmingham and the North.

Sporting and leisure activities in the area include a popular Rugby Club and Sports Club in Shipston; golf at Brailes, Tadmarton and Chipping Norton, racing at Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwick and Cheltenham, as well as easy access to world class theatre at Stratford-upon-Avon with an additional fringe at Chipping Norton.


