

Detached cottage in the heart of Dinas Powys



- Quaint cottage in the centre of Dinas Powys
- Mature, well-tended gardens
- Originally 18th Century, but extended over a couple of phases
- Excellent transport links and school catchments
- Offered with no onwards chain

Situation

Dinas Powys is predominately a commuter town, being just 5 ½ miles south west of the Capital City and 9 miles south east of J 33 of the M4 Motorway. The village has excellent transport links to the city centre with Dinas Powys railway station providing frequent services to Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan. The village is served by both Cardiff and Vale of Glamorgan bus services.

Description

Rothbury Cottage is set in the heart of the village, in beautiful gardens; an 18th Century property extended and improved over a couple of phases.

Entered into the lobby with door to the wc and steps to the integral garage with electric up and over door to the driveway. A door from the hall opens onto the open plan kitchen, with fitted wall and base units, ample worktop space and a dining area with window to the front.

The main hallway has stairs to the first floor and a couple of steps down to the living room, in the oldest part of the property. There are windows to the front, chimney breast with inset fireplace and a feature made of what would have been the original turning stairs to the first floor.

Upstairs there are four bedrooms, the principal bedroom in the oldest part of the property has windows to the front and a separate study.

Across the landing are three further bedrooms and a modern family bathroom with white suite comprising panelled bath with shower over, wash hand basin and wc. Through bedroom 3 is the largest of the bedrooms with two picture windows to the front and a generous dressing area.

Outside, there is driveway parking leading to the integral garage.

The gardens have been beautifully maintained with a lawn sweeping along the front with established borders of shrubs and trees and an ornamental pond, including a green house, raised crazy paved patio area with stone low wall and built in planters plus wrought iron railings and gate. To the side is a winding path through a mixture of fruit & vegetables and climbing roses leading to Mill Road.



















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




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




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
