Local information

Overway Cottage is situated in attractive countryside to the south of the Cathedral town of Bury St Edmunds, on the edge of Nowton Park.

This fine historic market town offers an excellent range of amenities with schooling in the public and private sectors plus extensive shopping and leisure facilities. There is ready access to the A14 just 2.5 miles to the north and mainline rail stations in Stowmarket and Cambridge, both with direct services to London.

About this property

The property is constructed of brick and flint under a pan tiled roof. Formerly a coach house and stable block, it now provides just over 2,500 sq ft of well proportioned accommodation over two floors.

The property was featured in the Skakin Stevens 1981 music video 'This Ole House'. The property enjoys a good level of natural light, with many rooms enjoying a double aspect and views over the mature, private gardens.

The ground floor accommodation comprises a spacious reception hall and cloakroom, a double aspect sitting room with open brick fireplace with wood burning stove, a snug with fireplace and a large dining room, partially divided and a deep bay window to the west. The kitchen has base and wall mounted units with an integrated induction hob, dishwasher, oven, fridge and freezer. There is also a utility room and steps down to a boot room.

On the first floor a large landing area gives access to a master suite which benefits from a double aspect, fitted wardrobes and en suite bathroom. There are a further three double bedrooms and an updated modern bath/ shower room.

Outside

The property is approached via a graveled driveway through a five bar gate which gives access to an enclosed courtyard area providing parking and a turning space with an open sided cartlodge. The landscaped gardens are arranged to the front, side and rear providing a high degree of privacy and seclusion with mature hedging and flint walls bordering most parts, lawned garden, a terrace and lean-to greenhouse.
