Situation

Barnsbury is a residential suburb in the London Borough of Islington. Set between the regenerated Kings Cross quarter and Angel, the area was home to Tony Blair and the birth of New Labour before Mr Blair made the trip across town to Downing Street.

Barnsbury Wood, a small nature reserve, which can be accessed from Crescent Street, is home to a selection of sycamore, ash and elder trees which provide a home to a variety of wildlife, and there is a selection of open spaces and garden squares in the area, almost all of which are open to the public.

The area features some of the most prestigious property in Islington, and some of the most beautiful streets, with Ripplevale Grove, Barnsbury Square and Lonsdale Square among the most sought-after addresses. Traditional English pubs serving upscale gastro fare to well-heeled clients mix with some more cutting edge offerings closer to Upper Street, and it is this mix of the traditional English charm on the doorstep of the bustle and international flavours of Upper Street and Kings Cross which lend the area much of its appeal.

Description

Exceptionally well presented two bedroom apartment set over the upper floors of a Victorian house in a charming, highly regarded Barnsbury road.

This beautiful property enjoys a private street entrance and staircase up to the accommodation, which is set over the first and second floors and features solid wood floors throughout. The apartment includes a bathroom benefitting from a separate shower and semi open plan kitchen.

Lambert Street is an extremely attractive residential road in central Barnsbury, comprising two short terraces of beautiful flat fronted early Victorian houses. Tree lined on both sides, the street is largely devoid of through traffic. The property is set over the upper floors of a house on the eastern terrace.

Caledonian Road is on two great bus routes. One going towards Kings Cross, Euston and then onto Charing Cross. And the other going towards Chancery Lane, St Pauls and then onto London Bridge.


Caledonian Road and Barnsbury Station is approximately 700 metres/km walk and is on the London Overground which has excellent links to central, west and southwest London.












SECOND FLOOR




