

A substantial family home in a Rutland village

Situation

The pretty village of Preston is located just under two miles North of the market town of Uppingham which provides a good choice of local amenities and facilities including a local market twice a week and a choice of excellent private and state schools. The A47 provides easy access to Peterborough, Leicester and beyond whilst the east coast mainline, running through Peterborough, allows easy access to London and the north-east of England.

The Property

The Pinfold is a substantial home set back from the road offering ample parking with a large private driveway and further garaging.

Built in 1974 the house has a fantastic layout providing flexible accommodation centering around the large family kitchen extension that was carried out in 2012. The contemporary kitchen features a central island with storage and seating and creates a divide between kitchen and living spaces.

To the left of the main body of the house, an internal hall provides access to a utility room complete with space for dog washing, further reception rooms and an entertaining space which could double up as office/study space and the

property's impressive indoor swimming pool. Alongside is a gym area, and space for a hot tub, with bar, a fully fitted sauna, changing rooms, two shower rooms and a plant room. To the right of the living kitchen there is a more formal reception space.

On the first floor are six bedrooms and four bathrooms. The principal suite overlooks the garden and includes a dressing area.

bedrooms and four bathrooms. The principal suite overlooks the garden and includes a dressing area, ample storage and a spacious en-suite with walk-in shower and separate bath. Three further bedrooms include en suite bathrooms, the remaining two sharing the large family bathroom. A staircase leads from the first floor landing to three large storage rooms in the loft space.

Outside, most of the garden is laid to lawn with plenty of privacy along its boundaries. The plot in total is approx 0.9 of an acre.




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
